

## **PASSENGER ORIENTATION ANNOUNCEMENT**

Welcome aboard the Rainforest Islander. Please listen for a moment to our safety announcement.

The passenger cabin has two emergency exits, the stair down at the right or starboard rear of the cabin, and the stair forward up to the pilothouse, then to the left or port to the escape ladder outside of the pilothouse.

Two 30 person inflatable life rafts are located on both side of the forward end of the vehicle deck. Life raft embarkation zones are the yellow painted areas on both sides of the vehicle deck.

Thirty adult lifejackets and 12 child's lifejackets are located on open shelves at the forward left or portside end of the passenger cabin. An additional 30 adult life jackets are located in a dropdown bin above the bottom of the stair down from the passenger cabin.

To put on a lifejacket, pull it over your head, uncoil the black strap, pull it around your back, and clip the hook into the ring on the front of the lifejacket. Tighten the strap by pulling on the free end. The life jacket is equipped with a light that will illuminate in the water, and a whistle. Passengers may ask crew members to demonstrate putting on a lifejacket.

Instruction placard for putting on a lifejacket are posted on the wall at the left or portside forward end of the passenger cabin, and on the wall around the corner from the bottom of the stair down from the passenger cabin.

All passengers are required to put on lifejackets at the Captain's direction.
